

CORNERS IN BLOOM

Corners in Bloom, a project of the Delta County Master Gardener Association, will encourage neighborhood volunteers to cooperate in designing, planting and maintaining small, manageable, and highly visible street corner gardens throughout Escanaba. The residents of each participating block will plant the corner plots at the street intersections. The project will both increase awareness of the upcoming Escanaba Sesquicentennial and support city beautification. On July 1, gardens will be judged for beauty, design, creativity and originality. Awards and recognition will be given for the top three corner gardens.
